Mt. Kailas and Manasarover Lake Tour, 21 Days

A pilgrimage to Mt. Kailash the sacred mountain of Tibet is sacred to both Hindus and Buddhists. Mt Kailash is the source of four great Asian rivers. For Hindus it is the throne of Shiva, for Buddhists, a gigantic natural Mandala. Also the epicenter of Tantric forces for both religions. The main highlight of this tour is tour to make the "ultimate pilgrimage" to holy Kailash and Manasarovar. This tour offers the ample chance to camp by the ethereal waters of the holy lake Manasarovar and to take part in a 3-days kora around Mt. Kailash. We can enjoy the spiritual journey in a holy and beautiful land being closer to nature & its beauty. This tour includes rigorous overland driving, trekking and camping through remote regions of western Tibet. The Guge Kingdom was founded in the tenth century by a descendant of the King Lang Darma, who fled from Lhasa after the collapse of the Tubo Kingdom. The Guge Kingdom survived about 700 years and disappeared mysteriously in the 17th century. The Guge ruins lie at a hill top near a river and cover 180,000 square meters. Houses, cave dwellings, monasteries and stupas are distributed on the hill and surrounding areas. There are palaces set on the submit and monasteries on the mountain side. The kingdom was enclosed by walls and also had many tunnels. Some of the structures remain in good condition at this time. The Guge Kingdom is famous for its murals. Sculptures and stone inscriptions can also be found on the surviving structures. The White palace, Red palace, Yamantaka Chapel, Tara Chapel and Mandala Chapel all still exist in good condition. The interesting exploration journey to Guge-Mt Kailash Mansarovar allows you to visit first remote destination then continue your overland journey to Lhasa. The cultural heart of Tibet, Lhasa sightseeing tour covers all the popular historical and cultural monuments. You will be visiting popular Potala Place, Jokhang Temple, Sera Monastery, Norbulingka and Tibetan traditional Bharkhor market and other many popular attractions of around.

	Drive from Darchen to Tarboche and start trek to Dira Puk 4900m, 6/7 hours for Mt Kailash Kora. Stay overnight at Camp.		
14	Trek from Dira Puk to Zuthul Puk. Trek from Dira Puk to Zuthul Puk 4890m, Crossing Dormala Pass 5630m, 7/8 hours. Stay overnight at Camp	camping	
15	Trek from Zuthul Puk to Darchen and drive to Guge Kingdom. Trek down to Near Darchen, drive 50 km, 3/4 hours to Guge Kingdom/Tsaparang 3780m. Stay overnight at Camp.	camping	
16	Drive back to Manasarover Lake. Drive back to Mansarover 105km, 4/5 hours via Toling monastery visiting. Stay overnight at Camp.	Camping	
17	Manasarover Lake to Saga. Drive from Manasarover to Saga. Stay overnight at Camp.	Guest house	
18	Drive from Saga to Nayalam. Drive from Saga to Nayalam 240km, 6/7 hours via Paikutso Lake. Stay overnight at Camp. 150km, 7/8 hours.	Guest house	

19	Drive from Nayalam to Kathmandu. Drive from Nayalam to Zhangmu Tibet border. After clearance the Chinese and Nepalese immigration formalities drive to Kathmandu and transfer to Hotel, 150km, 7/8 hours. Over night at hotel	3*Hotel KTM
